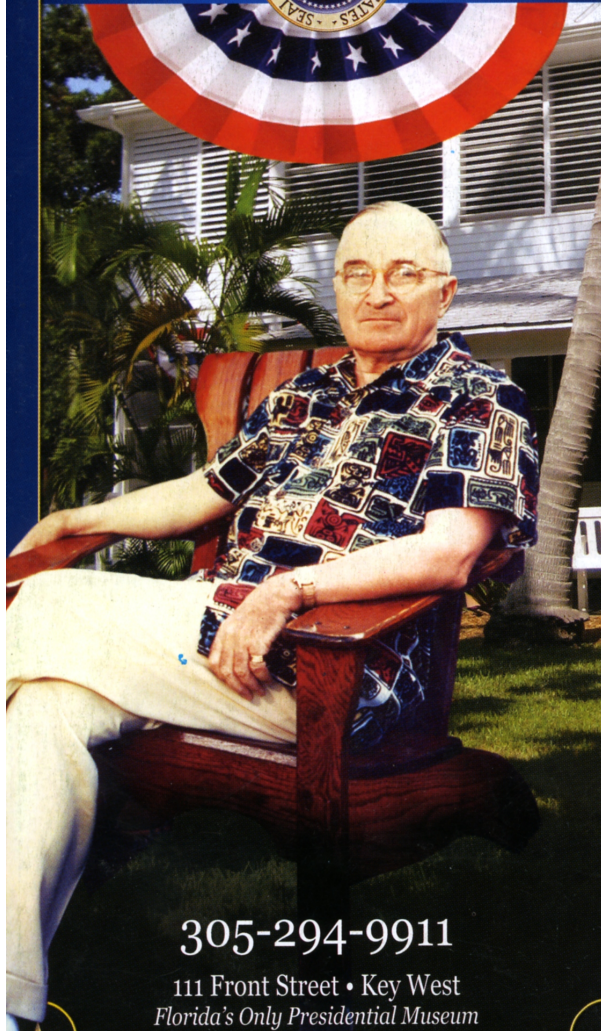

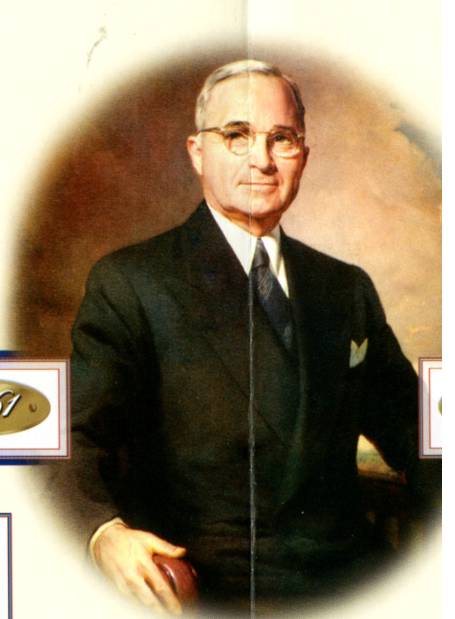
## Little White House Built

In 1890, the U.S. Navy builds an 8,700 square foot home on the waterfront to house the base commander and paymaster.



## Truman's First Visit to Key West

From 1946 to 1952, Harry S. Truman used the house 175 days as both a retreat and functioning White House. It was while at the Little White House that President Truman enacted a Civil Rights Executive Order.

## Clintons Visit Key West

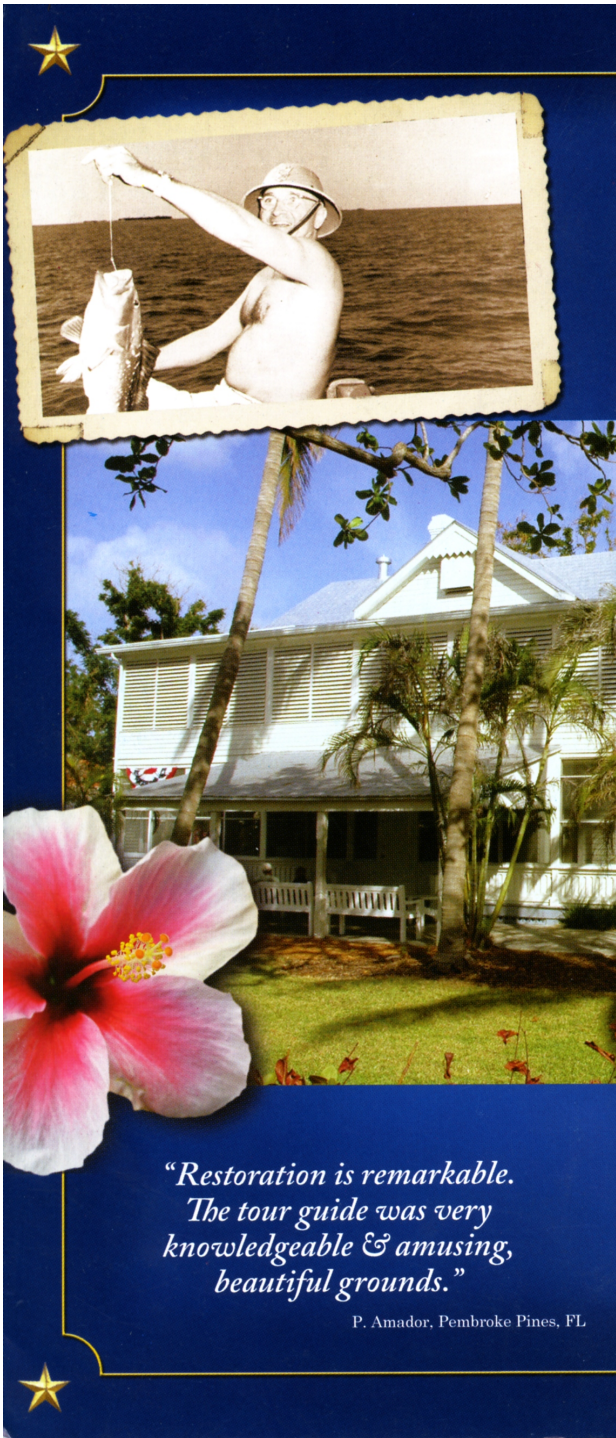
While visiting the island, Senator Hillary and former President Bill Clinton stayed at the Little White House for a relaxing weekend.
