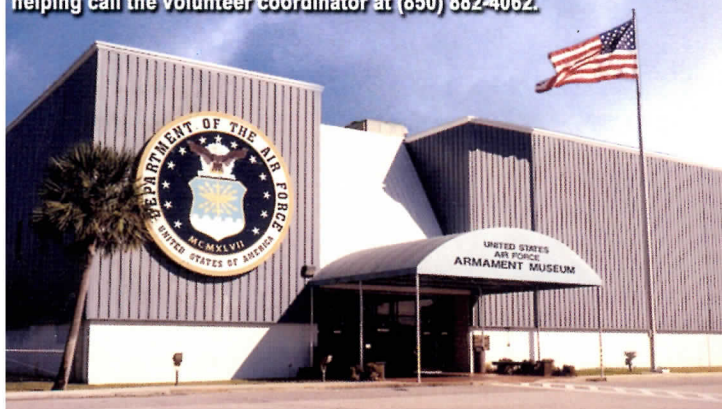

VOLUNTEERS:

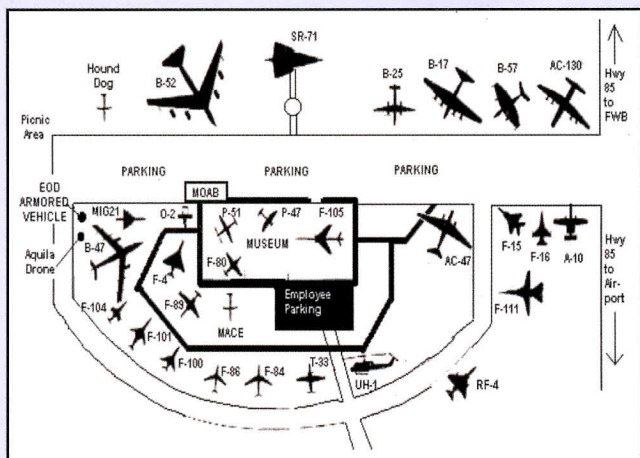
